

Cyber Safety: "Safe or Not Safe?"

Help kids practice thinking through online choices by sorting actions into "Safe" or "Not Safe" categories. This game builds awareness, encourages discussion, and helps kids understand how to stay safe online.

How to Play:

- Cut out the action cards.
- Lay the two category labels on the floor or table: SAFE and NOT SAFE.
- Read each card aloud or let the child read.
- Ask your child to place the card in the correct category.
- After each one, pause to talk briefly about why it is safe or not.

SAFE	NOT SAFE

A friend sends you a message in your game

You ask an adult before downloading a new app

A stranger asks where you live

You click on a pop-up that says "You've won!"

You keep your password secret

You do not tell anyone your password

Someone you do not know wants to chat

You ask for help when something feels wrong

You post a picture with your full name

You share your school name with someone online
